Early September - the venue as ever is Hassocks, the weather is glorious and yet once again our players are gathered to do battle for the Pink Ball Trophy.

Playing conditions for the 20 members and 4 guests were perfect, but on the extremely dry ground the ball did run far and often wide, while the greens were simply lightning fast. To the frustration and chagrin of many a player, so often a delicate and tentative downhill putt would gather speed, race past the hole and finish up off the green! These problems were eventually reflected in an average score for the day of 26, not quite as good in comparison to the 28 recorded at our recent Coulsdon meeting.

Despite this and for the first time ever, a majority of the teams kept their pink ball right up to the 19th hole. Only 2 groups failed to do so, with one having to resign on the 3rd with only 3 points to their credit, while the other quartet, with a total of 11, just failed to get half way round before their ball met a watery grave! The 2 players who were responsible for losing the pink ball shall be nameless, but their photos do appear on page 3 as they feature prominently in the Hall of Shame!

The winning team, who came off the 18th green triumphantly holding their ball aloft, was the deadly combination of Sue McD, Malcolm and guests, but also potential members, Kam Wong & Mick Shiel. Their combined score was an excellent 32pts.

But what about the individual scoring? With the Wayfairers Trophy and other nice prizes up for grabs, Mike Church showed it was well worth the long drive from Great Yarmouth to be with us. His excellent score of 34pts couldn't be beaten, although one or two came close. Just behind Mike on 33 was guest Richard Davison and he had the nerve to walk off with both the Birdie Cap and the Nearest the Pin prizes. Ken! He's your guest! You should tell him firmly that if he wants to return it's no way to behave!

Yet another competition was for the "50 Bob Set" in which age is added to score. With 2 octogenarians in the field, all they required was a reasonable score and this was exactly what David Rose did. His score 27, added to his age 83 was unbeatable. Well done David!

Basking in the glorious sunshine after the golf everyone went inside for a very pleasant substantial meal. The raffle draw was made, followed by the traditional prize giving and after an excellent day, it was time to go home with lots of happy memories.

AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING - OUR AGM MEETING TO BE HELD AT BLETCHINGLEY GC ON MONDAY 21st OCTOBER

We look forward to a full turn out of members for our 18th Annual General Meeting to be held at Bletchingley Golf Club. Those who have been with the Society since the early days will no doubt remember this venue which we visited regularly up until 2003, but for those who joined later than this, it will be a first time. Currently the Course, which is 18 holes, is in excellent condition. As it is fairly long at just over 6,000 yards, with 5 par 5's, some players may well wish to book a buggy. Water does feature on a few holes so pack your fishing rods!

DIRECTIONS. The Golf Course is very easy to find, being right in the centre of the village of Bletchingley, near the Church in Church Lane. For Sat Nav. the post code is RH1 4LP. The phone number is 01883 744848. Please leave home in good time to be at the Clubhouse for coffee at 9am.

Our AGM will start promptly at 09.20 and a maximum of 50 minutes allowed for the meeting with any unfinished business to be discussed after the evening meal (never yet had to happen in 17 years!)

Golf is scheduled to begin at 10.34 but at Bletchingley it will be different. In order that players don't have to hang around after the AGM waiting for their tee time, we have been given 2 separate starting slots - both at 10.34. Half of the field will start on the 1st and the other half on the 10th. Because of this, there will be no need for the usual putting

competition which was introduced as a "time filler" and never happened at Clandon last year because of the atrocious weather conditions. A 2 Course Meal with coffee will be served at approx. 4.30pm.

The main prize of the day will be the Ron Harris Autumn Cup (held by Bill Eslor) with the winner also taking the Wayfairers Trophy (currently in the safe hands of Mike Church). This is also the occasion that the identity of the Society Champion and Ladies Champion are revealed - total of the best 3 scores recorded during the past 12 months. Finally the winners of the KO Pairs Competition will receive their prizes and accolades, thus bringing another Wayfairers year to its conclusion.

COST £35 This covers coffee on arrival, 18 holes, a 2 Course Meal with coffee and all prizes. A real bargain for an excellent venue.
