Our recent visit to Hassocks was the 11th consecutive September gathering at this popular venue and was well supported in attracting a turn out of 30 players - 28 members and 2 very welcome guests. The day started misty and grey but by the time the last group out was under way the sun was shining on a glorious early Autumn day.

This was the occasion of the annual Pairs Contest, with everyone doing battle to win the Two Ronnies Trophy but as in the year previous, partners were not revealed until after the event! As pairs of cards were drawn and names and scores announced the lead kept on changing hands. However eventually, the deadly combination of Sue McD and John B. were pulled out together and as both of them had recorded 30pts this amounted to an unbeatable total of 60. Congrats Sue & John - what a lovely couple you make!

As regards the main individual event, in which everyone was doing their best to win the Wayfairers Trophy, the result couldn't have been closer. Four players finished on 32 but just edging them out with 33 was Robert Crompton. Well done Sir! An extremely severe handicap cut couldn't happen to a nicer fella! Average score for the day was 26 so Robert was 7 points better than this.

All members of our older generation (plenty of them!) were also hoping to do well in the Annual Competition for the 50 Bob Set in which a player's age is added to their score. The eventual winner of this was octogenarian Ken Cooper who finished with an unsurpassable total of 110!

The Course was in its usual good condition, although several players found the greens deceivingly fast, this being in great contrast from our previous meeting at West Chiltington where difficulty was found in getting up to the hole!

With the golf done and dusted welcome drinks were served on the sunbathed patio before it was time to adjourn for what proved to be an excellent and extremely noisy meal.

Following this a very enjoyable raffle & prize giving ceremony took place before it was time for all to head for home.

And that folks brought yet another memorable Wayfairers' year to an end with our AGM meeting coming up in October. Hopefully see you there!

## AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING - OUR AGM MEETING TO BE HELD AT BLETCHINGLEY GC ON MONDAY 13th OCTOBER

We look forward to a full turn out of members for our 19th Annual General Meeting to be held for the second successive year at Bletchingley Golf Club.

DIRECTIONS. The Golf Course is very easy to find, being right in the centre of the village of Bletchingley, near the Church in Church Lane. For Sat Nav. the post code is RH1 4LP. The phone number is 01883 744848. Please leave home in good time to be at the Clubhouse by 9am.

Coffee will be provided at this time (no bacon rolls) and our AGM will start promptly at 09.20 with a maximum of 55 minutes allowed for the meeting. Any un inished business can be be discussed after the evening meal (never yet had to happen in 18 years!)

Golf is scheduled to begin at 10.34 with as last year a 2 tee start. In order that players don't have to hang around after the AGM waiting to go out, we have been given 2 separate starting slots - both at 10.34. Half of the field will start on the 1st and the other half on the 10th. A 2 Course Meal with coffee will be served at approx. 5.15pm. As it's a long day and a fairly lengthy Course, members might wish to buy a snack from the Club kitchen or bring something with them to eat on the way round.

The main prize of the day will be the Ron Harris Autumn Cup (held by Val Ward) with the winner also taking the Wayfairers Trophy (currently in the safe hands of Robert Crompton). Hopefully this is the occasion that Mike Vardon will be available to bring one of his great-uncle's famous trophies for some photographs with the day's winner but this will be confirmed or otherwise nearer the time.

Later at the prize giving the identities of the Society Champion and Ladies Champion will be revealed - total of the best 3 scores recorded during the past 12 months. Finally the winners of the KO Pairs Competition will receive their prizes and accolades, thus bringing another Wayfairers year to its conclusion.


