August Bank Holiday Weekend turned into 3 continuous days of dismal drizzle, rain and gloom so it was with some trepidation that all those Wayfairers involved anticipated the next day - the day of the annual pilgrimage to Hassocks. As usual there was no need for anxiety - plenty of blue sky, warm sunshine and the best day for ages. The Wayfairers did it again! 23 Members and 4 guests took to the field to find that because of the recent weather the Course was green & lush but the ball did not run anything like the distance of previous years. Despite this a very reasonable average of 26 pts per player was achieved.

There were lots of Competitions with various trophies to be contested with the two major ones being the 2 Ronnies Pairs Trophy and the Wayfairers Individual Shield. Prior to going out to play our Match Day Co-ordinator organised the draw for the various playing pairs and this was carried out to the accompaniment of many "Oohs" & "Ahs" as the final combinations were revealed.

Ultimately it proved to be an extremely close competition with the deadly partnership of Ruby & Kam (40pts better ball) just edging out into 2nd place Sue McD & Robert who came in just one point adrift on 39.

It was interesting to note that a male/female combination finished both 1st & 2nd and this was similar to the result of the previous year. Doubtless the ladies spur the men on!

In the Individual Event Robert Crompton swept the board with an impressive return of 34 pts (8 above the average) and this total was 2 ahead of two other players, both of whom finished with 32. Robert however was not content with this! Having won the Wayfairers Trophy and finished 2nd in the 2 Ronnies, he also had the audacity to win the Jeff Hogg 18 + Under Trophy as well! The scissors will be well and truly out!

The other individual competition was for the 50 Bob Set where age is added to score and this went to a comparative youngster, 76 year old John Bateson who with a combined total of 108 narrowly beat octogenarians Ken Cooper & Bob Histed on count back. A very tight finish.

Sunshine and drinks on the patio were the order of the day after playing and this was followed by a hearty traditional meal and the usual "banter filled" raffle & prize giving. A good day and it was nice to see that summer had not quite deserted us yet!

<u>AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING - OUR AGM MEETING</u> TO BE HELD AT BLETCHINGLEY GC ON MONDAY 19th OCTOBER

We look forward to a full turn out of members for our 20th Annual General Meeting. DIRECTIONS. The Golf Course is easy to find, being right in the centre of Bletchingley near the Church in Church Lane. The post code is RH1 4LP & phone number 01883 744848. Please leave home in good time to be at the Clubhouse by 9am. Coffee will be provided at this time (no bacon rolls) and our AGM will start promptly at 09.20 with a maximum of 55 minutes allowed for the meeting. Any unfinished business can be discussed after the evening meal (never yet had to happen in 19 years!)

Golf is scheduled to begin at 10.34 with as last year a 2 tee start. In order that players don't have to hang around after the AGM waiting to go out, we have been given 2 separate starting slots - both at 10.34. Half of the field will start on the 1st and the other half on the 10th. A 2 Course Meal with coffee will be served at approx. 5.15pm. As it's a long day and a fairly lengthy Course, members might wish to buy a snack from the Club kitchen or bring something with them to eat on the way round.

The main prize of the day is the Ron Harris Autumn Cup (held by Graham Ward). The winner also takes the Wayfairers Trophy (currently with Robert Crompton).

Later at the prize giving the identities of the Society Champion and Ladies Champion will be revealed - total of the best 3 scores recorded during the past 12 months. Finally the winners of the KO Pairs Competition will receive their prizes and accolades, thus bringing another Wayfairers year to its conclusion.

COST £36. This covers coffee on arrival, 18 holes, a 2 Course Meal plus coffee and all prizes. The same price as last year. A bargain for an excellent venue.

WAYFAIRERS MEMBERSHIP - SOME OBSERVATIONS

Currently we have 49 members, however at all our meetings over the last year we did well to attract half this number on any one occasion. Through no fault of theirs, lots of members can only play occasionally. As an example in the last year we have had 7 full meetings & 3 "casual" ones. Records show that over all ten of these, 8 members never played at all, one member once and two just twice. On the other hand we have 6 enthusiastic guests who all play fairly regularly. Despite their presence we have never come close to our agreed maximum of 36 players on any one day. This is not a hidden request for any member to resign as we welcome your support & company. However it seems wrong to turn away keen potential members.

In view of this, your Committee are considering submitting a proposal, to be voted on at the AGM, that membership should be offered to some or all of our regular guests who are on the waiting list. However in order not to overload our numbers at the expense of current members, we would ask any of our "infrequent" members who anticipate playing more regularly, to let Tony know this please when renewing their membership. This can then be taken into account when reviewing the number of vacancies we will have available.
