AT HOEBRIDGE GUEST LYNNE PLAYED AN EXCELLENT GAME WHILE DENNIS THE MENACE SCORED EXACTLY THE SAME!

The Wayfairers first outing of 2016 coincided with the warmest day of the year so far with wall to wall sunshine, one player in shorts and several exposing themselves just in shirt sleeves. We had done it again - and it was only mid-March! Wait until July comes! Despite many other local Courses still being sticky and muddy Hoebridge was in really excellent condition, with 5 pairs taking full advantage of the Club's excellent supply of brand new buggies.

In total 28 players took to the field and this included 4 very welcome guests. The summer like conditions resulted in some good golf with 6 players managing 30pts or more. The average score for the day was 26 and all handicaps have now been thoroughly reviewed!

There were 2 players on top of the pile and these were guest Lynne MacDonald and old timer Dennis Shelley who both scored 34pts. However as Lynne was a guest and as such cannot win any of the Society's silverware, both the Wayfairers Shield and the John Peake Spring Trophy went to founder member Dennis. Lynne did go home however with the very best bottle of wine on the table - a vintage 2015 Chateau du Bateson! Cheers Lynne (and apologies John!)

The playing groups Team Competition was also very fiercely contested ending in a very tight finish before the eventual winners could be determined but as everyone in the top two teams won prizes all concerned went home happy.

The recently introduced Par 3 Challenge has settled in nicely now and the result for this was also extremely close. There are 5 par 3's at Hoebridge and Damon took the trophy and the bottle of bubbly with a total accumulation of 13pts for all 5 holes. This excellent effort just pipped Mick Shiel and guest Paul Yarranton who both came close behind with totals of 12. Although the beneficiaries of our next charity fund raising have not yet been agreed, money is already building up under the Treasurer's watchful eye and this was added to at Hoebridge through the medium of the Last 3 Holes Secretary's Challenge. Anyone who blobbed on any of the last 3 holes, which included the dreaded 17th, had to put £1 in the pot. To offset this however any player who managed to score a total of 7pts or more could take a £1 out of the pot. Three extremely skilful (or was it lucky?) contestants managed to do just this but some very generously took it out and then dropped it back, thus giving a final result of £18 to put away towards our next good cause.

Amid all the after match chatter a much enjoyed roast meal was served in the late afternoon and this was followed by the raffle and prize-giving before a happy and sunburnt gathering set off for home on their diverse routes. An excellent start to our 2016 season.

Our more elderly players will be pleased to learn that despite being tree-lined, tight and tricky in places, it is flat and measures just 5524 yards. Given fair weather it should be ideal for the Wayfairers.

This is the day we play for Peer's Plate the current holder being Spencer Atwell and the winner as ever will take the Wayfairers Trophy won recently at Hoebridge by Dennis Shelley We shall also be doing battle for the Par 3 Champions plaque over Poultwood's 5 Par 3 holes. In addition there will be the usual Playing Groups Team Competition plus the Nearest the Pin and 2 Longest Drive Contests.

<u>OUR CHARITY</u> Following our Hoebridge day our next Charity received a very welcome £18 from the players who all so kindly recorded a blob somewhere over the last 3 holes. In the near future members will get the opportunity to propose and vote for the next Charity that we shall support in the forthcoming 15 months.

<u>IN MEMORY</u> Recently all members have received notification of the death of Ron Harris and been given details of the funeral arrangements. Winning the Ron Harris Autumn Cup or Two Ronnies Trophy will now take on a new significance.

Very sadly we have to report that Ron is not the only one as prior to his death we had notice that both founder member Robert Marchbank and retired member Stuart Allan had also died. Robert was a relation of Frank Houlihan and despite living miles away in Dumfrieshire in Scotland he was staying with Frank on the day the Wayfairers Society was formed. Being a keen golfer he came along with Frank and John Bateson recalls vividly that when it was agreed to form a Society, he was the very first to pay the £5 entry fee thus becoming our first member. On the occasion of his 50th Birthday Robert's wife presented the Wayfairers with a £50 cheque to buy something appropriate for the Society. After much debate the 50 Bob Set was purchased, this being a beautiful miniature set of golf clubs in a bag mounted on a trolley. Because it was in recognition of a special birthday it was agreed the trophy should be presented annually at one of our meetings and the winner should be the player who achieved the highest total when his or her age was added to their individual Stableford score. With Bob being the recognised abbreviated name for Robert the trophy was appropriately named. Living as he did so far away in Scotland Robert could rarely join us but whenever he was visiting Frank and this co-incided with one of our meetings he was always there. Eventually he was granted honorary life membership and he continued to support the Society often very generously. Unfortunately he became dogged with ill health and did not manage to play with us again for some time before his sad demise.

Stuart Allan joined us in the early part of the new millenium and became an enthusiastic member of the Wayfairers. He walked with a pronounced limp but this didn't affect his enjoyment of the game and the company of others. He was always smiling and always cheerful. Due to increasing ill health and his lack of mobility he regretfully resigned his membership in October 2008.

These are 3 members who will be sadly missed but have left nothing but very happy memories for all of those who remember them.
