AT FOXBRIDGE PETER RUSHTON LEAVES THE REST WAY BEHIND AND ALL THE TEAMS LOSE THEIR PINK BALLS FOR OTHERS TO FIND!

The 3rd week in June saw the Wayfairers make their annual visit to Foxbridge to compete for the Pink Ball Trophy. Despite the time of year days of heavy and at times torrential rain put the whole venture in jeopardy. Would buggies be in? Would the Course be open? Eventually there was no cause for concern. The day broke bright, warm & sunny and although in places it was wet underfoot, considering the deluges conditions were surprisingly good.

The main problem was that due to all the rain it had not been possible to mow the fairways with the result that in many places the ball did not run far. Apologies for this were issued by the Club but there was little they could do and the main thing was our members got to play.

The turn out for the day was extremely low with just 16 players going round the 18. However this was not due to the weather but unfortunately our date chosen months in advance, coincided with so many other events in which our busy members were engaged - holidays, visitors staying, essential appointments elsewhere, family gatherings etc.

As would be expected with the Course conditions being as they were scoring was low with an average of just 23 and the individual competition won with a score of only 31. Compare this to last year when the average was 28 with the winner scoring 39. Then 9 players scored 30 plus and this year it was just one! And who was this worthy winner? None other than founder member Peter Rushton. Well done Peter! No one could match or beat your 31!

This feat gained him not only the Wayfairers trophy but also the prestigious Vardon Trophy and it was great to have Mike Vardon with us to make the presentation in memory of the many golfing achievements of his very famous Uncle Harry.

For the very first time ever every team lost their pink ball before completing the 18 holes! The winners were clearly the deadly combination of Sue McD. Peter Morris, Malcolm Goman & Peter Rushton as they manoeuvred their ball all the way to the 18th where Peter Rushton promptly lost it in the water with his tee shot! As this team scored more with their pink ball before losing it than any others, they were declared as winners.

The field may have been small but they made up for it creating a happy noisy atmosphere afterwards in the Clubhouse and during the meal. The winner of the Lost Ball Competition and just who had drawn who in the Open Draw were announced (see pages 3 & 4) and following the prize giving it was time for all to depart on a pleasant warm Summer's evening.

AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING TO BE HELD AT SURREY DOWNS GC ON TUESDAY 26th JULY 2016

Our next meeting is the eagerly awaited visit to Surrey Downs and is a Club we have never visited before. The main reason for this is because it is out of our normally accepted price range but this is the occasion of our biennial subsidised day for members and for all those available to play you are in for a real bargain! The Course is north of Junction 8 on the M25. Follow the A217 in the direction of Sutton but before travelling very far there is a turn off from a roundabout to the right signposted Kingswood. Follow this and not far past Kingswood Golf Club then Surrey Downs will appear on your right. Post code KT20 6JS. Further details in the final circular.

Traditionally our July meeting is the day we play for the President's Trophy so all players will be in one of 4 teams - Treasurer's (current holders), President's, Match Co-ordinator's or Secretary's. Playing groups will be announced in the final email.

All members of the winning Team will receive a Wayfairers' ball but WARNING! - all members of the 3 losing teams will be required to put £1 in the charity pot! Remember this as you line up those putts! Prizes will be plenty as the top 2 scorers in each Team both receive a prize. The member with the top score of the day will also become the proud custodian of the Wayfairers Trophy and currently Peter Rushton holds that honour. Not only will the fortunate winning member take our Society Trophy but we are also competing for the second year for the magnificent David RoseBowl (present holder Spencer Atwell). The Par 3 Challenge Plaque will be up for grabs also and all the other usual minor competitions will be contested.

Following the draw for Open players at Foxbridge the results and prizes for the lucky winners will be presented as the Open is played and concludes over a week before our Surrey Downs gathering. Our normal raffle will be held and hopefully Richard Thomson will be present to act as our ticket salesman. He guarantees to give everyone a winning ticket!

The day begins with coffee & bacon rolls as from 10am. First tee off 11am. At approx. 5.45pm sit down for a 2 Course Meal followed by tea or coffee.

Your package will consist of coffee/bacon rolls, 18 holes, a 2 Course Meal with tea or coffee and the cost of loads of prices. The true cost is £48 per player but with a joint subsidy for every member from the Main Fund and Raffle Fund the cost is reduced by one third to just £32. The bargain of the year! Don't miss it!
