What a day Robert Crompton had on our recent inaugural visit to Reigate Hill Golf Club. As can be seen from the results listed below, he won 5 separate competitions which included 4 trophies! Reigate Hill was a new location for the 22 members and 2 guests who all turned up early for an eagerly anticipated competitive golf day. And why was everyone so early? Was it that they were all anxious to learn their fate as this was the day on which players were competing for the Two Ronnies Pairs Trophy and until our Match Day Organiser drew the pairings, amid a hushed apprehensive audience, no one knew just who their partner would be or the order in which they would be playing. All very tense! A bit like the pairings for Strictly Come Dancing! Once everyone knew and had bonded with their partners the golf commenced in heavy clouds and a light persistent drizzle. These conditions continued for the first 9 holes but then the skies lightened and the day became dry and warm, so much so that before the evening meal the players, having showered and changed, all assembled on the patio which nicely overlooked both the 9th & 18th greens. It was agreed the Course was difficult but in good condition and excellent value for money, so plans are already under way to return next year. The star of the day was without any doubt Robert Crompton who walked away with almost everything but unfortunately couldn't stop for the prize giving so was unaware of just how well he had done. The average score for the day was a not very high 25 but Robert exceeded this comfortably with a return of 31pts. AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING - OUR AGM MEETING TO BE HELD AT BLETCHINGLEY G.C. ON MONDAY 31st OCTOBER

We look forward to a full turn out of members for our 21st Annual General Meeting. DIRECTIONS. The Golf Course is easy to find, being right in the centre of Bletchingley near the Church in Church Lane. The post code is RH1 4LP & phone number 01883 744848. Please leave home in good time to be at the Clubhouse by 9am. Coffee will be provided at this time (no bacon rolls) and our AGM will start promptly at 09.20 with a maximum of 55 minutes allowed for the meeting. Any unfinished business can be discussed after the evening meal (never yet had to happen in 20 years!)

Golf is scheduled to begin at 10.34 with as last year a 2 tee start. In order that players don't have to hang around after the AGM waiting to go out, we have been given 2 separate starting slots - both at 10.34. Half of the field will start on the 1st and the other half on the 10th. A 2 Course Meal with coffee will be served at approx. 5.15pm. As it's a long day and a fairly lengthy Course, members might wish to buy a snack from the Club kitchen or bring something with them to eat on the way round.

The main prize of the day is the Ron Harris Autumn Cup (held by Richard Thomson). The winner also takes the Wayfairers Trophy (currently with Robert Crompton)

Later at the prize giving the identities of the Society Champion and Ladies Champion will be revealed - total of the best 3 scores recorded during the past 12 months. Finally the winners of the KO Pairs Competition will receive their prizes and accolades, thus bringing another Wayfairers year to its conclusion.


