IN A HEATWAVE AT HEVER SUE MAC STOLE THE DAY WHILE PARTNERLESS ROBIN JELLEY SANG "I DID IT MY WAY!"

Our first ever visit to Heyer coincided with an absolute heatwave with the temperature rising by mid-afternoon to a sweltering 35 degrees! This is the day on which playing partners are drawn just prior to going out, with the 2 Ronnies Trophy the prize for the top pair.

In theory there should have been 7 groups of 4 competing but at the very last minute Bill Eslor had to withdraw leaving one player without a partner. When the draw was made this unfortunate person turned out to be Robin Jelley. Undeterred, solo Robin scored well enough that when after playing he was given in a draw a mystery partner's score to calculate what he would have finished with if this had been his partner, the resulting 2 Ball Better Ball result of 41pts was the best of the day. Well done Robin - the new holder of the 2 Ronnies Trophy - all on your own!

As the day progressed with an ever increasing temperature all the players crawled in at the finish extremely hot, weary and with some near to exhaustion. However no one gave up and the bar did extremely well! Outside the bar there is at Hever a lovely terrace patio and despite umbrellas out at all of the tables it was completely deserted as not one Wayfairer dared venture outside on to it! Enough was enough! Officially the hottest day for 40 years! Wayfairers weather taken to extremes! As well as the pairs competition there was also the usual individual contest with the Wayfairers Trophy sitting centre stage ready to be given to the eventual winner. The Princes Course is not very long but very likely as a result of the intense heat the scoring was not quite as high as was anticipated, with an average of 25 per player being recorded.

The winning score was achieved by the only player not to lose a ball and this was Sue McD who came in with an excellent total of 37pts. In very close second place just 1 point behind this was Richard Thomson followed by Eddie with 34. The Handicap Committee are making careful notes! It was a golden day for Sue as she also won the Par 3 Challenge Plaque and together with her drawn partner John Humphrey they finished second in the Pairs Competition, just being edged out by that man Robin by 1 point.

Upon arrival in the morning all players had opportunity to guess how many balls in total would be lost during the course of the day and also everyone drew 2 top professional players for the forthcoming Open Championship to be held at Birkdale in July. With the Open Draw replacing the raffle on this occasion it was straight into the Prize Giving following the meal but John McD did take the opportunity to remind every one that the next meeting -Reigate Hill on Monday 24th July - is our Grand Final Charity Day. AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING TO BE HELD AT REIGATE HILL ON MONDAY 24th JULY 2017

Our next meeting, which is our second visit to Reigate Hill, is our much anticipated Charity Day when we bring our 16 months fund raising for Parkinsons UK, to its conclusion. Hopefully there will be a very full turn out of members to support this special occasion.

This is the day of our annual Team Challenge Competition, at the end of which the winning team will walk off with the President's Trophy - currently held by the Treasurer's Team. The selected playing groups will be published a few days in advance. All members of the winning team will receive a Wayfairers golf ball but WARNING! - all members of the 3 losing teams will be required to put a £1 in the Charity pot! Prizes will be plenty as the top 2 scorers in each team both receive a prize. The member who comes in with the best individual score of the day will receive the Wayfairers Trophy (current holder Sue McDonnell) plus the much coveted David Rose Bowl.

The main source of charity income will be from the raffle which will take the form of a tombola and the appeal to all players is to bring a donated prize to enable all those present to win a prize! Tickets will be on sale at £5 a ticket with the expectation that each member will buy one ticket. Each prize will then be given a number matching all those that have been sold. It is hoped no one will get their own donated prize back but it is something that could and has happened!
