AT POULT WOOD MIKE COLENUTT WAS BEST OF THE BATCH SCORING 43 PTS - QUITE IMPOSSIBLE TO CATCH!

26 members turned up to play at Poult Wood on what turned out to be a glorious Spring day with the attractive 18 hole Course looking green, fresh and inviting.

As the terrain is fairly flat and the distance covered not overlong - just 5300 yards - it is a Course which is ideal for our elderly Society and usually each year the scoring is high. Last year the average with 27 playing was 29 and this year it was not far behind with the 26 players averaging 27.

Despite this, in a charity fund raising competition it transpired that between all the 26 players a total number of 93 blobs had been recorded! An average of 3.5 per player. Just one participant managed to keep a clean sheet and this was our clear winner Mike Colenutt who came in with an almost obscene score of 43 pts! No one else could match this, the closest being Graham Ward and John Benstead who both finished on 38. This excellent score would normally have been almost certainly the highest of the day but even with this success, they were still 5pts behind "Mighty" Mike!

The outstanding achievement won Mike both Peer's Plate and the Wayfairers Trophyand also a most well deserved handicap cut! Mike went home laden, as he also won the Par 3 Challenge Plaque and was in the Playing Group which came 2nd in the Team Event. Last year Poult Wood gave rise to the Norman Conquest but this year it was quite definitely Mike's Massacre!

Graham Ward was another star as not only did he finish 2nd, he also won the 18 & Under Jeff Hogg Trophy and was in the winning Team Competition Playing Group.

As this was the first full meeting of the year, with Chartham Park having been cancelled in March, there was a very happy lively atmosphere in the Clubhouse following the golf and during a most enjoyable meal. After this came the usual banter which always accompanies the raffle and the prize giving and then it was time to go home but knowing it is only 4 weeks to the next reunion - this time at Reigate Hill.
