Members should all have received an email informing them that due to a very recent devastating fire at Cottesmore Golf Club we have had to cancel our meeting there and it has been rescheduled for Monday 13th August at Villa G. C. replacing what was to have been a "casual day" gathering on this date.

Complimentary coffee will be served from 09.00 and toasted sandwiches available to purchase at your own expense. The golf to be played over 18 holes commences at 09.50. Following the golf it's all move on to nearby Sweetwoods Golf Club where a Two Course Meal will be served at approx. 16.30 with a raffle and the prize giving to follow on after this.

As well as competing for the Wayfairers Trophy (now with Derek Allen) this is the day of our traditional President's Team Shield Competition so all players will be in one of 4 Teams - Secretary's (current holders), Treasurer's, Match Co-Ordinator's and the President's. The playing groups will be announced in the final details email. This is also the day that our top scorer of the day walks off with not only the Wayfairers Trophy but also with the very much coveted David Rose Rosebowl which is currently in the hands of Peer Blakeley.

Prizes will be plenty as there will be 3 individual prizes for best scores and all the members of the winning team will also receive a Wayfairers golf ball but WARNING! - all members of the 3 losing teams will be required to put £1 in the charity pot - with a smile! Remember this as you sweat over those short putts!

It doesn't quite end there however as also there will be the usual playing groups team competition, the Par 3 Challenge Plaque Contest and there will be all the other usual minor contests to test your golfing skills.

By this time the Open Championship at Carnoustie will have taken place and prizes will be presented to the lucky 4 contestants who drew the players who secured the top 4 places. It really is Prize Giving Day! There will be the usual raffle and very many thanks to Bill Eslor who has volunteered to sell the tickets.

<u>COST FOR THE DAY</u> Cost for coffee, 18 holes on a very pretty Course and all prizes is <u>E34 AND THE DEADLINE TO PAY</u> is <u>FRIDAY 13th JULY</u>. If you are going away on holiday at this time please remember to pay before you go. In fact why not pay <u>NOW</u> then it's done. Guests are welcome providing we have space. Let Tony know if you wish to bring a guest and he can then advise you of availability on 13th JULY.

AND THE NEXT MEETING AFTER VILLA This is at Ifield on Monday 3rd September and only just over 2 weeks after our Villa day. This does not give much time to produce and circulate the next Wayfairer, request payment for Ifield, get the money in and allow Tony time to chase up all the non-returns in order to establish our final playing numbers. Ifield will be subsidised by the Raffle Fund and with this subsidy the cost per head to cover all aspects of the day will be just £30 a head. A fantastic bargain for an excellent venue.

It is anticipated the email will be posted round about the 21st July with payment and return information required by 13th August, which is the day many of us will meet up at Villa.
