BLETCHINGLEY WAS A WAYFAIRERS' WASHOUT!

With a very late change in the weather forecast 20 rather damp members set off from home to play in our Annual Autumn Cup Meeting at Bletchingley only to find on arrival that a common sense decision had been made to postpone the fixture. During the week previous heavy rain had fallen forcing Course closures and buggy bans. However with an improvement over the weekend a firm decision was made by the Club Management that use of buggies would be permitted for our Society day and members were duly informed.

Early Monday morning saw the forecast for some possible light showers change suddenly to heavy rain and although as promised buggies were being allowed just for our Society, after discussion a mutually agreed decision was made to cancel. Rain was pouring down and the conditions were so heavy and wet that use of buggy areas was restricted. Also there was always the chance of some accidents in the very slippery conditions (just ask Liz!) so possibly a very wise decision was made.

However cancellations always causes complications! On what day should we plan to rearrange the gathering bearing in mind that in November - just a few days away - on most Courses buggies are not in use right throughout the winter until April? Postponement until a day in April was agreed but as there is no guarantee that buggies will be available straight away from 1st April, the decision was made to hold the event later in the month in hopefully suitable conditions.

Easter Sunday is 12th April. People are very often away during the week leading up to Easter and similarly in the week following after the Bank holiday. So eventually the finally agreed rearranged date is MONDAY 20th APRIL when hopefully all is dry, buggies are buzzing and the birds singing!

Hopefully! So if you already have a diary or calendar enter 20th April now!

The day's programme begins with coffee & bacon rolls available from 9.20am. with the first playing group to go out for a 10.00am. start. The Competition is an 18 hole Texas Scramble and also incorporated into this will be the usual 2 Longest Drives, Nearest The Pin and the ever popular Shortest Drive which now has its own much coveted trophy! Should any skilful individual manage to get an unaided birdie, then the Birdie Cap could be theirs to wear and doff! The current holders of the Scramble Trophy are Eddie & Jackie Samways, Robert Crompton & Carl Rosner.

Repeated as in previous years, there is one other little competition. The Christmas Tankard (current holder Robert Crompton) plus something appropriate to put into it, will go to the player who sinks the final putt on the 18th green and is in the winning Scramble Team.

Following the golf at approx. 4pm a Two Course Christmas Meal will be served and if space allows wives and partners will be most welcome. When our final playing numbers are confirmed the situation will be much clearer and hopefully we will see as many meal guests plus playing guests as capacity allows. There is no point in nominating anyone at this stage as this will not gain you any advantage whatsoever, so please do not submit any extra names with your return and further information on this will be duly circulated.

BUGGIES Apologies but at this time of the year unfortunately buggies are not in use at Holtye. Sorry for those for whom a buggy is essential but this situation is beyond our control and is likely to be the same no matter what other Course we had sought to select. However at times in the past when we have had 2 players who could walk 9 but not 18, they have combined to make 1 player in the Scramble. One joined a team for the front 9 and then the other came in for the back 9. If you would be interested in possibly doing this please let Tony know

Alternatively two or three of you might like to go out at the end of the field to play just a few social holes and whet your appetites and thirsts for the Christmas meal paying your own green fees if not Holtye members

It was agreed that in the Spring a charity should be adopted from members' nominations and that ongoing fund raising, mainly from fun golf related activities, should continue until the following year. After this the fund should be closed and payment made to the beneficiaries. From tiny acorns mighty oak trees grow! Over the past 11 years we have supported a total of 7 different charities and very often these charities have been ones very closely connected with the lives and very sadly the deaths of some of our members.
