As no one was allowed to win more that one prize during the day, several players with lower scores than these were amazed and delighted to find they had 'something to come!'

Jeff's score is made to look even more impressive when compared to the average of 28 for the day. The course was not at all easy, and made even more difficult by a swirling wind. This no doubt contributed to John Peake's success in securing the coveted Hedgehog Trophy. John amassed 39 points at Rookwood but could only manage 17 points at Reigate.

Similarly, Mike Church secured 42 points at Bletchingley before picking up the Hedgehog at Rookwood. Oh! the vicissitudes of golf! Jeff be warned


