What a glorious start the Wayfairers had at Clandon Regis for their New Year's programme as the golf began, following a very quickly dispatched AGM. The sun shone warmly out of a clear blue sky, and the Course and surrounding country side looked magnificent on what was a perfect Autumn day. (Incidentally as I write this the next morning the rain is teeming down!)

For a few the quality of the golf matched these conditions, but for the majority mastering the tricky greens remained a permanent problem. So frustrating!

33 members and two guests took part, but generally the day became very much a "Keep It in the Family" occasion. Our Lady Champion Liz Colenutt recorded a total of 89, very closely followed by Jan Henshaw on 88 & Sue McDonnell (87).

### AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING TO BE HELD AT HOLTYE G.C. ON FRIDAY 11th DECEMBER 2009

The day's programme begins with coffee, & bacon rolls available from 9.20am. with the first playing group out for a 10am. start. The Competition is an 18 hole Texas Scramble and incorporated into this will be the usual 2 Longest Drives, Nearest The Pin and the ever popular Shortest Drive! Should any skilful individual manage to get an unaided birdie, then the Birdie Cap could be theirs, and Our Match Co-ordinator is busily working out how he can award the Hedgehog to just one player, when the competition is a Team Event! (Don't worry - he has ways & means! Ed) Current holders of the Scramble Trophy are Peer Blakeley, Doug Wagstaff & previous guest Colin Scott. This is our annual Bring & Win event. The suggested value of prizes is £3 - £5 and please wrap your presentation - (and check the sell by dates! Ed)

Following the golf at approx. 4pm.we have a 3 Course Christmas Meal with coffee & wine - if we can persuade our tight fisted Treasurer to get into the Christmas spirit! As our maximum seating capacity is 44 it is not certain how much room, if any, there will be for meal guests. When final playing numbers are confirmed the situation will be much clearer. Cost for a meal guest is £18 but pay nothing for the moment, Should you wish to invite someone you can indicate this on the return slip, but no guarantee can be given that space will be available.

The COST for the day for Holtye members is £22 and for non-Holtye members £34 and this covers golf, all food & drink as described above, and all golf competition prizes. NOTE! Return slips to the Treasurer by Monday 16th November. This could prove to be a very popular meeting. Don't miss out - act NOW!

There is one other little competition not covered in the above cost. There will not be a raffle but as ever a fun Christmas competition, which this year is completely different, There will be no guessing players' scores or even players' ages! You are requested to pay a £1 entry fee on arrival at the Clubhouse. This could increase into a 1000% profit if you are the winner, as £10 will be given to the player who sinks the final putt on the 18th green and is in the winning Scramble Team! Whoever puts their shot onto this green nearest to the pin will, as the rules state, putt first. The other players will have to amicably agree (or argue like hell! Ed) as to who goes 2nd, 3rd & 4th. If no one sinks their putt the process will begin all over again! No doubt lots of "Ohs & "Ahs" as the ball approaches the hole, but the prize can only go to one player - sink it, and it could be you!

At the meal we will be rolling back the years to the last decade. In 1998 we held at our Christmas meeting a little contest that is well worth repeating, and will probably be new to the majority of our members. ### NOTES FOLLOWING THE WAYFAIRERS AGM HELD AT CLANDON REGIS GC ON THE 23rd OCTOBER 2009

<u>Secretary's Report</u> Average attendance at each full meeting during the year had been 37 with this figure being reduced to 30 for "casual" days. The highlight of the year was the very successful on going fund raising to support MacMillan Nurses Cancer Relief, which culminated with the sum of £750 being presented to this charity. It was also reported that the highlight of the 2010 programme hopefully would be the "100 Up" gathering at Ifield in May. Fund raising for our 2011 charity would commence in July next year with the members choosing the eventual beneficiary. Thank yous were expressed to Derek Reeves for all his website endeavours, to Sue McDonnell for organisation of the Wayfairers news letter, to Peter Rushton for acting as honorary auditor and to all the Committee.

<u>Treasurer's Report.</u> A healthy state of affairs for the accounts was reported and following some minor explanation of figures, the report was accepted with thanks to the Treasurer.

<u>Match Co-ordinator's Report</u> The M.C. ran through the variety of competition formats that we use and requested members' suggestions for new ideas to be tried. It was reported that a new Award for the Ladies Championship had been purchased, and Peer Blakeley was thanked for presenting a new trophy for our May gathering, aptly named Peer's Plate. The KO Pairs Competition had been successfully re-instated and any members who wished to play in this were informed that they should contact John B. immediately by phone or email - preferably with the name of their agreed partner. An order of merit board was displayed based on players' handicaps and this was left to be examined later in the day, so that members could see how the handicaps had affected not only their results, but the results of others.

Election of Officers All officers were re-elected en bloc.

<u>Membership</u> The Secretary reported 3 resignations and announced that due to health reasons 2 other members were not likely to be playing for sometime to come. Based on current membership figures the following proposal from the Committee was put to the meeting - that "Graham & Val Ward be offered immediate membership, but if accepted the membership should once again be closed, until the time comes when it would be practical to review the situation." This proposal was seconded and passed and Graham & Val accepted the offer with thanks. Resignations from Mike Wilson, Jan Henshaw & Doug Wagstaff were acknowledged and accepted with regrets from all present.

<u>Future Programme</u> The Committee's programme proposals for the next year were all accepted and the rationale of changing the traditional Holtye Texas Scramble Day from May to December was fully approved. As this then gave two Holtye meetings in a very short space of days - the Scramble followed by the Roll Up - a show of hands was requested to determine whether or not there would be enough support to continue with the Roll Up. The result indicated clearly that the Roll Up should carry on as usual.

The Raffle With the figures from the Raffle accounts being accepted & approved, members were warned that although the balance was very healthy, future expenditure on a new supply of Wayfairers balls and subsidising the "100 Up" day would bite quite deeply into the funds. An appeal was made to members to help in selecting raffle prizes. Members were invited to purchase what they considered would be popular prizes, ranging in price from about £4 to £12, but were instructed that they must obtain a receipt. On presentation of this and the prize to the Secretary they would be reimbursed. A reminder of the appeal should appear in the next Wayfairer.

<u>Website</u> After some discussion it was agreed that Derek should remove the necessity for a password to enter the site. It was also agreed that providing there were no objections from the members the contact list of names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses should be available on the website, but in a special area giving full member password protection. This proposal should be included in the next edition of the Wayfairer with a request that any members who do object should notify Derek, or the Committee, immediately. The scheme will not be introduced until 1st January 2010 and any member who prefers not to be included will be omitted from the list.

<u>Wayfairers Logo Clothing</u> After discussion and general agreement that a majority of members would like the opportunity of purchasing Wayfairers clothing, it was agreed that the Committee should work out the mechanics of ordering and purchasing these items in order to simplify the current processes, and when having done so report back to the members.

A.O.B. With no further business the meeting closed in excellent time for the golf to begin!

The competitions are to be played at a <u>mutually agreed</u> venue on a match play basis. Where one or more players are members of the chosen club all Green Fees are equally divided. Failure to meet any deadline will result in the Match Co-ordinator deciding the winners by the toss of a coin.

Ladies to play off ladies tees and play to ladies card and stroke index. On completion of each match the winning team are requested to notify the result promptly to John Bateson who, when he knows, will inform them who their opponents are in the next round.
