AT FOXBRIDGE IT'S GRAHAM WHO STAKES OUT FIRST CLAIM AS ROGER AND CARL SWING TO TWO RONNIES FAME!

Two Ronnies Day at Foxbridge - and it was Wayfairers Weather Plus! as 24 members gathered in glorious sunshine for the Annual Pairs Competition. As ever partners were drawn before play with many expressions of "Oh" and "Ah" and "I would much rather have had Tiger Woods" as the names came out of the hat.

Following bacon rolls, coffee and liberal applications of sun cream the golf got under way. With previous days of sun, wind and no rain whatsoever, the Course proved extremely difficult to master. Over the scorched earth the ball ran far and wide with some very peculiar and unpredictable bounces, and this was reflected in the scoring. Foxbridge is not a long Course but the final average score was only 26.

And who was the individual winner? That man again Graham Ward! 12 handicap Graham came in with 33pts just edging 10 handicap Sue McD into second place by one point. Some consolation for Sue, who has never won the Wayfairers Trophy, was that she took both the Nearest the Pin and Birdie Cap prizes. Hers was the only birdie of the day.

But what we do about this Graham fella? On his first outing as a guest he came second back in May 2009 at Cranleigh. This was followed by other guest appearances at Villa (section winner) and 4th place at Hassocks. Then the big mistake was made at Clandon by inviting him to join! He did and immediately celebrated by winning! H/cap down to 13. A joint 3rd at Foxbridge (February casual day) and 4th at Gatton reduced him to 12. But now off 12 he has won yet again! Could he be our first ever scratch player!

In the Pairs Competition there were clear cut winners. In scoring 41pts "Cunning" Carl and "Jolly" Roger combined excellently to walk away with the Two Ronnies Trophy leaving Graham (him again!) and Ron B. in 2nd place on 38.

Following the heat of the golf it was a welcome drink on the patio with the shade of the sun umbrellas much in demand. Foxbridge then provided an excellent meal with all their usual friendly hospitality, and a most enjoyable day drew to an end as all the prizes and platitudes were finally exhausted. The 101st gathering and another unqualified success!





Rules.

Any handicap adjustments are to be made as the Competition proceeds. Current Wayfairers Handicaps at the time of playing will be on the website and in the latest editions of the Wayfairer. Any queries regarding handicaps please refer to John Bateson (01342 832602).

The competitions are to be played at a <u>mutually agreed</u> venue on a match play basis. Where one or more players are members of the chosen club all Green Fees are equally divided. Failure to meet any deadline will result in the Match Co-ordinator deciding the winners by the toss of a coin.

Ladies to play off ladies tees and play to ladies card and stroke index. On completion of each match the winning team are requested to notify the result promptly to John Bateson who, when he knows, will inform them who their opponents are in the next round. Also the current situation will be constantly updated on the website.

HANDICAPPING - a reminder. The lowest handicap player plays off scratch and the other players receives strokes on the basis of 3/4 of the difference between their handicaps and the lowest handicap - strokes to be taken at the appropriate stroke index holes
