With the roads also clear, everyone arrived in good time for the AGM which was efficiently dispatched in under 40 minutes by Deputy Chairman Brian Girling. 34 players, including 2 guests, then prepared for the 18 hole task lying ahead and this was very much enjoyed by all concerned, despite the usual varied results, as the Course was in such excellent condition.

The average score for the day was 25 but one or two players rose well above this. Kevin Stacey reported on having had "the round of his life" as he came in with an unbeatable score of 37pts. Even under the normal handicapping set up this would have resulted in him being cut, but under our

Society system he will be mutilated! And he won't be the only one! Mike Church, who obviously is spending every spare minute out on his local Course scored 35pts, won both of the longest drive competitions and had 2 birdies! Fortunately Damon matched this with 2 birdies of his own, so not all the prizes went to Mike. It was however very much a "keep it in the Bateson family day" as guest Andrew finished 2nd on count back over Mike, and their incestuous playing group walked away with the Team Competition prizes!

As the players came off the Course, the putting green became the centre of attention as all strived to ensure that their team would walk away as the winners. As it happened the final results were very close indeed. At the later prize winning ceremony annual awards were presented as well as ones for the day's competitions. Much to his surprise and obvious delight Norman was announced as Society Champion of the year, and he was so pleased he immediately sank half the bottle of beautiful Italian wine that he had just won for his putting prowess! Sue was declared as Lady Champion of the year, a well earned award as she has been runner up on so many occasions. The format for both championships is the total of the best 3 Stableford scores recorded throughout the year. Well done Norman & Sue.

At the meal a birthday toast was given to Graham Ward who in order to celebrate his recent anniversary very kindly put wine on the table, and this was followed by an ear splitting rendition of "Happy Birthday to You" directed not only to Graham, but to all our members, as this was also the occasion of the 16th Birthday of the Wayfairers.

AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING TO BE HELD AT HOLTYE G.C. ON MONDAY 12th DECEMBER 2011

The day's programme begins with coffee & bacon rolls available from 9.45am. with the first playing group out for a 10.30am. start. The Competition is an 18 hole Texas Scramble and incorporated into this will be the usual 2 Longest Drives, Nearest The Pin and the ever popular Shortest Drive! Should any skilful individual manage to get an unaided birdie, then the Birdie Cap could be theirs, and our Match Co-ordinator will somehow or other work out how the Hedgehog can be awarded, despite the absence of an individual competition. Current holders of the Scramble Trophy are Spencer, Bill, John B. and guest and ex-member Syd Tutton.

Repeated as last year there is one other little competition. The Christmas Tankard (current holder John Bateson - it's that man again!) will go to the player who sinks the final putt on the 18th green and is in the winning Scramble Team! Whoever puts their shot onto this green nearest to the pin will, as the rules state, putt first. The other players will have to agree amicably (or argue like hell! Ed) as to who goes 2nd, 3rd & 4th. If no one sinks their putt the process will begin all over again! The COST for the day for Holtye members is £20 and for non-Holtye members £32 and this covers golf, all food & drink as described above, and all golf competition prizes. NOTE! NOTES FOLLOWING THE WAYFAIRERS AGM HELD AT CLANDON REGIS GC ON THE 21st OCTOBER 2011

Apologies for Absence received from Peter Rushton, Barry Richards, Bill Eslor, John & Barbara Horsfall, Mike & Audrey Riddles & Chris Wilkes. Also Bob Histed & Annie Hitam (late arrivals) In the absence of Barry Richards the chair for the meeting was taken by Brian Girling.

Secretary's Report During the year the average attendance including guests at full meetings had been 32, reduced to 26 for "casual days". Highlight of the year was our Charity Day at Ifield in July 2011 when the culmination of 12 month's fund raising for Leukaemia & Lymphoma Research was concluded. The final total raised was £1420 and this had been passed on to the Charity. In early Summer 2012 voting will be arranged to decide on the next Charity to be adopted by the Society with members to suggest possible worthy recipients. As part of the next year's programme a Members' Subsidised Day will take place at Sutton Green G.C. in July. Finally thank yous were issued to Sue McD, Derek, Tony, John B. and Peter Rushton for their work for the Society over the past year.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> After some brief explanations from the Treasurer the audited accounts were accepted without question by the meeting which expressed best wishes to Tony regarding his recent purchase of a new caravan and his forthcoming Christmas cruise!

<u>Match Co-ordinator's Report</u> The M.C. reported on yet another successful and varied competition year and invited the meeting to contact him regarding suggestions for any new formats or revision of existing formats.

Election of Officers All officers were re-elected en bloc.

Membership With much sadness the Secretary announced the death of Stuart Saunders earlier in the year with the report that the Society had been well represented at the subsequent Memorial Gathering. Tony Roche had regretfully announced his resignation, was sorry to leave and sent his best wishes to all members. After brief discussion it was agreed unanimously that John Horsfall & Barry Richards be offered Honorary Life Membership. It was reported that currently the Society had 42 full members and 7 life members of whom only 1 played regularly. After discussion it was agreed that the waiting list for membership should be re-opened but actual invitations to join be left to the discretion of the Committee.

<u>Future Programme</u> The outlined programme for 2012 met the full approval of the meeting with the Members' Subsidised Day eagerly anticipated. It was reported that negotiations with Holtye G.C. for the traditional Christmas Roll Up were due to be made and that members would be kept informed of the outcome.

Raffle The accounts for the Raffle Fund were approved and accepted and the Secretary repeated his invitation for members to purchase suitable prizes for which they would be re-imbursed.

Handicaps John Bateson had produced an "Order of Merit" based on players' handicaps and performances during the year and this was displayed to be examined by members and put on the website. As a result of this review David Williams and John Cunnington had gained shots but no-one had lost any.

Pairs KO Tournament The M.C. announced that this had run very smoothly and that the 2011 Winners would be announced later in the day. Agreed it should run again in its present form next year.

Wayfairers Clothing Agreed that the contact details of our supplier should be put in the next Wayfairer so that members could see on line what was on offer together with their price list.

<u>A.O.B.</u> Agreed that the B & Win should continue in present form with gifts left unwrapped. When selecting a suitable prize members should ask themselves "Is this something that I should really like to win?" A proposal that the Open L. Drive be limited to handicap players of 18 & Below was rejected almost unanimously. Brian Girling was thanked for taking the chair and the golf began!
