THE TALE OF CLANDON WAS A VERY WET STORY -BUT BILL & KEVIN SUBMERGED WITH TROPHIES AND GLORY!

17 years of "Wayfairers' Wonder Weather" came crashing to an abrupt halt when the Society gathered recently for their AGM day at Clandon Regis. As the early morning meeting proceeded at its usual brisk pace, anxious looks were constantly being cast outside at an extremely damp dismal day, but at this stage there was no rain falling. The dull but dry conditions continued until all 24 members and 4 guests were out on the Course, with all hoping and praying that the forecast for heavy showers would not materialise. It wasn't to be however and eventually down came the rain - and didn't it come down!

Later the car park became a steamy scene of soaked Wayfairers, all dripping water as they attempted to load their cars with saturated golf equipment. However, following a hot shower and a welcome drink in the cosy bar, things looked much brighter and the usual Wayfairers' ambient atmosphere was carried into the meal where 70 year old John Cunnington was toasted with his own wine and the Society's 17th birthday celebrated in style. Forgetting the weather what about the golf? Considering the conditions, the Course played acceptably, although extremely long, as was reflected in a final average score for the day of just 22pts. One player, Bill Eslor, rose right above this however. Striking the ball in the wet conditions extremely well, he came in with an excellent total of 34pts. As Bill finished 3 clear points ahead of guest Gerald Winter, his handicap is now down to almost single figures! Bill's achievement won him not only the Wayfairers Trophy, but also the Autumn Cup together with loads of other prizes.

As the Pairs KO Final had not been completed by the deadline date no prizes for this were presented, but Kevin Stacey went home proudly clutching the Society Champion's Trophy. Well done Kevin and well played! Liz Colenutt was announced as the winner of the Ladies Championship, but as she was not at Clandon the trophy will be presented at a later date. After a very wet day's golf, the journey home proceeded in atrocious conditions not helped by two accidents on the M25 which brought traffic to a standstill in places. Let's hope the weather for the first meeting of our new year was just a blip and not a sign of things to come! See you at Holtye in December and bring your waterproofs!

The day's programme begins with coffee & bacon rolls available from 9.15am. with the first playing group out for a 10.00am. start. The Competition is an 18 hole Texas Scramble and incorporated into this will be the usual 2 Longest Drives, Nearest The Pin and the ever popular Shortest Drive! Should any skilful individual manage to get an unaided birdie, then the Birdie Cap could be theirs, and our Match Co-ordinator, after many sleepless nights will somehow or other work out how the Hedgehog can be awarded, despite the absence of an individual competition. Current holders of the Scramble Trophy are Barbara Horsfall, Eddie Stanley, Andy Knight & John McDonnell.

Repeated as in previous years, there is one other little competition. The Christmas Tankard (current holder Eddie Stanley) will go to the player who sinks the final putt on the 18th green and is in the winning Scramble Team. Whoever puts their shot onto this green nearest to the pin will, as the rules state, putt first. The other players will have to agree amicably (or argue like hell!) as to who goes 2nd, 3rd & 4th. If no one sinks their putt the process will begin all over again! The prize can only go to one player so sink it, be in the winning Team and the Tankard will be yours!

This is our annual Bring & Win event. The suggested value of prizes is around £5 and following the decision made at the 2011 AGM please leave your presentation unwrapped. When choosing what to put on the table please also remember the maxim agreed at that AGM by asking yourself the question - "Is this something that I would really want to win?" With all the Bring & Win prizes that have had to be purchased over-spilling on the table, this is the one meeting of the year where we don't have a raffle or something similar.

Following the golf at approx. 4.30pm.we have a 2 Course Christmas Meal with mince pies, coffee and due to a certain nameless lady member (Val Ward) who celebrates her 60th birthday, there will be wine on the table. As our maximum seating capacity is 44 it is not certain how much room, if any, there will be for meal guests. When final playing numbers are confirmed the situation will be much clearer. Cost for a meal guest is £15 but pay nothing for the moment, Should you wish to invite someone you can indicate this on the return slip, but no guarantee can be given that space will be available.

The COST for the day for Holtye members is £20 and for non-Holtye members £30 and this covers golf, all food & drink as described above, and all golf competition prizes. NOTE! Return slips A.S.A.P to the Treasurer and no later please than by Monday 12th November. This could prove to be a very popular meeting. Don't miss out - act NOW! Should you wish to invite a playing guest please indicate this on the return slip, but send no money until the response from members is known as to how many are coming.

HANDICAPS FOR HOLTYE

NOTES FOLLOWING THE WAYFAIRERS AGM HELD AT CLANDON REGIS GC ON THE 19th OCTOBER 2012

Apologies for Absence received from Barry Richards, David Williams, Derek Reeves & Spencer Atwell, who was representing the Society at the funeral of Doug Wagstaff's wife. Chris Wilkes also sent apologies as he would be arriving late. The chair for the meeting was taken by Peter Rushton.

<u>Secretary's Report</u> During the year the average attendance including guests at full meetings had been 32, with "casual days" attracting a record average of 31 players. The highlight of the year was the day at Sutton Green attended by 34 members and 2 guests, when members were subsidised by nearly 40% from the Society & Raffle Funds. This special day also attracted a temperature of over 30 degrees, so it was memorable for more than one reason.

Earlier in the year members had opportunity to nominate a new Charity to be adopted and when it came to voting The Alzheimer's Society won majority approval. Fund raising had been ongoing and would continue until the culmination day in July 2013. It was reported that 2 new members Ruby & Russell Woolley were invited to join the Society at the end of 2011 and had accepted. Finally thank yous were issued to Sue McD, Derek, Tony, John B. and Peter Rushton for all their work for the Society over the past year.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> After some brief explanations from the Treasurer the audited accounts were fully approved and accepted by the meeting

<u>Match Co-ordinator's Report</u> The M.C. asked the meeting for suggestions for new formats for the coming new year but as none were forthcoming and everyone seemed satisfied with the status quo, it was agreed to continue at all the various meetings as previously. Following a query concerning the distances some members had to travel to reach venues, the meeting was assured that no Golf Courses were chosen that were more than one hour's journey from home given normal traffic flow and this assurance satisfied all those present.

Election of Officers All officers were re-elected en bloc.

<u>Membership</u> John Bateson reported that despite membership being very high, 2 regularly attending guests Derek Allen & John Benstead recently had been invited to join and had accepted, with the result being that there would be no further membership vacancies for the foreseeable future.

<u>Future Programme</u> The outlined programme for 2013 met the full approval of the meeting. The venue for the meeting on 22nd July was now confirmed as Slinfold G.C. and negotiations were due to take place with Holtye Management regarding finding a possible date for the Xmas Roll Up. Members were warned that following many years of little or no price increases, future gatherings were likely to cost around £35 for the full day's package and on some occasions after dinner coffee would not be included.

<u>Raffle</u> The accounts for the Raffle Fund were approved and accepted with the Secretary reporting that the Fund was in a healthy position thanks to the support of all the members.

<u>Handicaps</u> John Bateson had produced an "Order of Merit" based on players' handicaps and performances during the year and this was to be displayed for examination on the website. The review showed that the vast majority of members were all within 3 shots of the average. As a result of the review, 3 members have been reduced by one shot each and 4 players have been given back a shot.

<u>Pairs KO Tournament</u> As the final had not been played and decided before the deadline date it was announced that this year's competition was to be abandoned. Eddie Stanley volunteered to take over organising the competition and stated he would be in contact with all members early in 2013.

<u>Wayfairers Clothing</u> As some members expressed interest, agreed the contact details of our supplier, together with some of the clothing on offer and prices should be displayed on the website.

<u>A.O.B.</u> Due to the inclement weather it was agreed to cancel the traditional AGM putting competition. (As it turned out a very wise decision!) Peter Rushton was thanked for taking the chair.
