

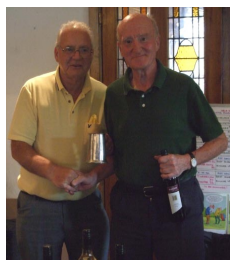


WAYFAIRERS CASUAL DAY AT VILLA FARM

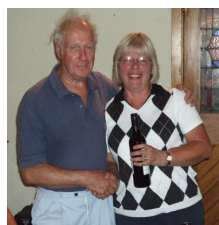
Added to this was a playing group Team Competition which proved to be very hotly contested resulting in an extremely close finish.
