## AND SO TO OUR NEXT MEETING TO BE HELD AT THE 9 HOLE PRINCES COURSE AT HEVER GOLF CLUB ON WEDNESDAY 21st JUNE

Wednesday 21st June - the longest day of the year for daylight hours and what better way to celebrate than by joining your fellow Wayfairers at the delightful 9 Hole Princes Course at Hever Golf Club. In the past our numbers in June during a popular holiday period have been low and therefore we have only reserved tee times for 20 players. We may be able to increase this number BUT AN EARLY REPLY IS ESSENTIAL to secure a place, as even if we are granted more spaces allocation will be on a strictly first come first served basis. This is a delightful new venue for the Wayfairers which we have been able to secure at a very competitive price so if you want to play please let Tony know AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to avoid disappointment.

For those who have never played at Hever the post code for Sat Nav is TN8 7NP The day will begin with coffee from 09.00 with the golf, which is to be played over 18 holes, due to start at 10.06.

As this is the occasion on which members all draw 2 players for the forthcoming Open to be held this year at Royal Birkdale, there is no raffle. Instead upon arrival everyone will be relieved of £2 and find out later which of the top professionals in the world they have drawn. Results and prizes will be issued at our July meeting at Reigate Hill. Also in the money payable in advance for the day to Tony will be added £1 and this is the entry money for you to take part in "Guess The Total Number of Balls That Will Be Lost During The Day Competition". All takings for this will go into the Charity Fund and the lucky player who makes the most accurate prediction will be suitably rewarded with an appropriate prize. Guesses to J. As regards the Golf Competitions this is 2 Ronnies Trophy day so don't be late as around 09.30 John B. will be drawing all the players' names from the hat and just who is partnering who will be revealed.
